



Extra help for people in East Sussex this winter

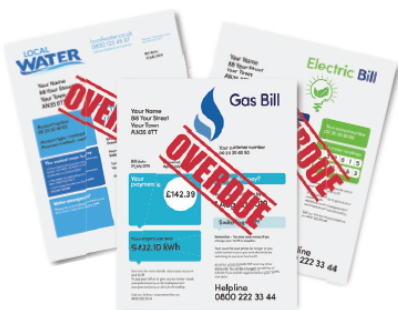


People in East Sussex can ask for help during winter.



You might be able to get some help if you find it hard to:

- keep warm at home
- pay bills like gas, electricity and water



Types of help you can get

Warm Home Check

If you are worried about keeping warm at home and don't have much money, you might be able to have a Warm Home Check.



The Warm Home Check Service can:



- give you advice and support on how to stay warm at home



- pay to make your insulation better. Insulation is a type of material you can put in your roof or attic. It helps to keep warm air inside your house



- pay to fix boilers or sometimes pay for a new one
